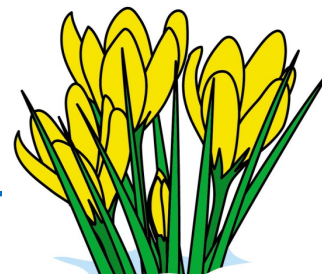

ONLINE PAYMENTS

From January 17 we would like to have a cashless dinner money system in school. Dinner money can be paid on line and a letter will be sent out in September providing you with the relevant information.
